### JOHN JAYNE

Judo was introduced into Great Britain in 1899, when [Edward William Barton-Wright](#) sponsored a visit from a team of Japanese [judoka](#) with the intention of establishing a [jujutsu](#) school in [England](#). The United Kingdom's first Judo [dojo](#), the [Budokwai](#), is the oldest in [Europe](#) and was founded by [Gunji Koizumi](#) in 1918 with Yukio Tani as its chief instructor. In 1948 the BJA was established as the national body representing Judo in the United Kingdom.

John began Judo at the famous Budokwai in London at age 3 ½. At age 6 he moved to the Pinewood Judo Club, where he stayed for about a year and a half before moving to his present club in London, Moberly Judo Club, when he was 8 years old.

John has now won ten British National Championships — two A-band (2007 at -34 kg and 2008 at -38 kg), two pre-cadet (2009 at -46 kg and 2010 at -55 kg), four cadet (2011 at 73 kg, 2012 at -90 kg, Jan 2013 at -90 kg, Dec 2013 at +90 kg) and two junior (Dec 2013 at -100 kg and 2014 at -100 kg).

Representing Great Britain John won two Top Ranking European Cadet Cups in 2013, placed 5<sup>th</sup> in the Cadet European Championships and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the European Youth Olympic Festival, also in 2013, before being released by the BJA. Representing the USA at the end of 2013 John won the World/Open European Cadet Sambo Championship, held in Latvia and won the Senior President's Cup in the US, beating the 2012 Paralympic Silver Medalist at -100 kg. John began 2014 ranked 1<sup>st</sup> in Europe in Cadets at -90 kg and 1<sup>st</sup> in the United States in the Senior Ranking at -100 kg. While still a Cadet this year John placed 5<sup>th</sup> in a Senior Continental Open and 5<sup>th</sup> in the Senior British Open European Cup in London at -100 kg.
